


BN 3 day phase B (November RamTap2024)







FOR DRESSAGE JUDGES

Below are some, but not all, variations to the USEF Dressage rules that you may encounter while judging Eventing dressage at national Horse Trials. Please refer to *USEF Rulebook* for further details (ELOC update 12/1/2024).

EQUIPMENT

Neck Straps made primarily of leather | Permitted. (Subchapter EV-10.2k)

Saddle Pad Logos | Permitted; sponsor logos must be 200 sq. cm or less (FEI Article 541.2).

May be any single color, contrast trim and piping permitted. Striped or multi-colored pads prohibited. (EV Subchapter 10.2i)

Spurs | Optional for all levels. Must be smooth metal, max length of shank 4cm from boot to end of spur and pointed toward rear. (Subchapter EV-9.4)

Noseband tightness | Rule wording: "may never be so tight as to harm the horse." (Subchapter EV-10.2b(1))

Wavy bits (i.e., Happy Mouth with bumps) | Permitted (FEI Eventing Annex A)

French Link snaffle | Permitted. (FEI Tack App)

Dr. Bristol | Permitted. (FEI Tack App)

ATTIRE

Half Chaps | Permitted for all levels; black or brown, full grain smooth leather with matching boots. (Subchapter EV-9.5f)

Jackets | Optional through Preliminary. Required for Intermediate and Advanced unless waived due to extreme heat. (Subchapter EV-9.5b)

Gloves | Only required for Intermediate and Advanced. Optional for Preliminary and below, but must be dark, tan, beige or white. (Subchapter EV-9.5a)

Helmets | Any color, discreet accents permitted, including national flags. (Subchapter EV-9.5a)

Breeches and Jodphurs | White or light colored only for eventing dressage. (Subchapter EV-9.5e)



USEA 2025

EXECUTION OF TEST

Fall of rider

Not eliminated, but penalized by effect on movement, and in collective mark. If horse leaves ring: Eliminated. (EV119.3 and EV 118.9)

Boots or bandages in ring or around outside, whips when not allowed, or discrepancy in dress Two (2) points in "other errors" column, not cumulative. Must stop and correct, may have assistance. (EV119.2a)

Entry before bell, or late entry 45-90 seconds Two (2) points "other errors", not cumulative. (Late entry over 90 seconds = Elimination.) (EV119.2b)

After initial error, ask rider to stay in ring and try to ride correct test. Most riders know both tests of their level. If they have 3 errors, they are scored as a "E" for Elimination. They are not permitted to leave ring, learn test, and return.

(EV118.11 and EV118.9)

2025 EVENTING RULES VARIATIONS

FOR SHOW JUMPING JUDGES

Below are some, but not all, variations to the USEF Jumper rules that you may encounter while judging Eventing show jumping at national Horse Trials. Please refer to *USEF Rulebook* for further details (ELOC 12/1/2024).



USEA 2025

COURSE

Water Jump | Not permitted; however, a liverpool no wider than 1.8m with rails over the water is permitted (EV150.5).

If a liverpool is used at the Training level, it must be built as a vertical over the center of the liverpool tray and a straightforward alternative obstacle must be offered. (EV Appendix 1.3c).

Jump Cups for Rails | Minimum 20mm, Maximum 30mm (EV150.6).

Start and Finish Lines | Between 6m and 15m from the first and last obstacle (EV147.3).

Novice and Beginner Novice | Only the A element of a combination may be a spread fence (EV Appendix 1).

TACK/ATTIRE

Spurs | Maximum 4cm measured from boot to end of spur. Rowels must be smooth, no tines (EV Subchapter 9.4).

Martingales | Only unrestricted running martingales with rein stops or Irish martingales are allowed (EV Subchapter 10.3b). Double rein stops are not permitted (FEI EV Tack App).

SCHOOLING

Obstacles | Fences must not be raised more than 10cm above the maximum height permitted for the relevant level (EVII1.5).

For Modified level and above, the warm up area must include at least four obstacles which are capable of being set as spreads. (EV 135.2d).

Placement Rails | Not permitted. Ground lines may be placed directly under, or up to 1m in front of the fence. (EV111.5).

Earphones | During warmup or training sessions, athletes and grooms may only wear one earphone while mounted (EV139.1.).

EXECUTION OF TEST

Second Disobedience Training and below | 8 penalties (EV128)

Exceeding the Time Allowed 0.4 penalties per second over (EV127.3)

20 or More Penalties Training and above | Compulsory Retirement (EV127.8)

Fall Before Starting

Disobediences, Falls, etc., occurring between the signal to start and the Athlete crossing the start line in the correct direction, must not be penalized (EV124.1b)

Responsibilities of Licensed Official The Licensed Official responsible for judging show jumping is responsible for the clock, the audible signal, and its use (EV124, EV126.5b)

Unauthorized Assistance

Any intervention by a third party (including verbal) with the object of helping the Athlete or Horse, regardless if it is solicited, between crossing the start line to begin the course and crossing the finish line after jumping the last obstacle, is not permitted, and may be penalized by Elimination. (exception: handing an Athlete headgear or spectacles. (EV
